<i>Had to jump around the syllabus - confusing and at times lost. Re-write slides to make them clearer. Lecturers should do more than just read whats on the slide. Just reading what's on the slide may not clarify the point and is often inadequate enough to be confusing.</i>		
<i>A little less diadactic learning. More videos and interative portions. Please order slides in same direction as presented. Add notes page.</i>		
<i>Bigger role play group scenario in higher stress simulated situation.</i>		
<i>Clearer role playing - and even more role playing and structed so that we get drilled. If possible.</i>		
<i>Changes to IV Basics: Actually do "piggy back" and "flushing the line"/"aspiration" into an orange or something. Changes to Emerg: Clearer needle stick slides.</i>		
<i>The "acting out" scenarios could be modified (ie. more specific...are they an IV or injection or acupuncture) since this could affect the emergency procedures utilized.</i>		
<i>The dimension fo pneumothorax presented on day 1 was inadequate. Trevor's presentation of pneumothorax included treatment, when to refer. That was much better, but needed to be presented on day 1 for those students.</i>
