<i>Practicum useful.</i>			
<i>Since it is a required course, all NDs have to take it.</i>			
<i>Needs to be more relevant to non-IV NDs.</i>			
<i>Yes for IV, emergency support for acupuncture could be a 1/2 day course in emergency.</i>			
<i>Yes-anyone doing IVs. I still don't think it's applicable for acupuncture but IV's definitely.</i>			
<i>For someone who doesn't do IV Therapy - most of course content was mostly not relevant to daily practice.</i>			
<i>I think it needs to be tweaked for those not doing IVs so for that I would not recommend this course.</i>			
<i>Good for overall knowledge and for emergencies, but shouldn't necessarily be mandatory for acupuncture alone. However, delivery and material good in general.</i>			
What would you change about this course?			
<i>The course seems more geared towards IV and injection therapies. It doesn't seem like new material (not in school) was presented in relation to doing acupuncture.</i>			
<i>Divide the IV & acupuncture into groups. Larger room or more tables and chairs because hard to write when so close and tight.</i>			
<i>Have a shorter course for acupuncture docs - Great teachers!</i>			
<i>A separate course for NDs who do not use IVs (half day course).</i>			
<i>For acupuncture - remove all situations of IV. Reduce to 1/2 day emergency response course.</i>			
<i>I think a \$450 course on IV based issues is not needed. But was very informative.</i>			
<i>Shorter/adapt for non-IV practitioners accordingly - 3 hours likely adequate due to lower risk of non-IV treatment.</i>			
<i>For those not doing IV's a half day course without any IV info would be sufficient and I would recommend a course like that.</i>			
<i>Decrease cost for acupuncture only portion.</i>
